### The Schedule of Categories is:

#### FLOWERS AND PLANTS:

- 1. A single rose stem
- 2. Three stems of roses
- 3. One dahlia stem
- 4. Three stems of single variety of flower not listed elsewhere in the schedule
- 5. Six fuchsia heads in a container
- 6. A single cut flower of any variety
- 7. A vase of any single variety of cut flowers
- 8. A flower arrangement including lavender
- 9. A vase mixed cut flowers
- 10. Any pot plant

## **VEGETABLES:**

- 1. Three tomatoes
- 2 Five cherry or small variety of tomato
- 3. One cucumber
- 4. Three potatoes
- 5. Three runner beans
- 6. A pair of courgettes
- 7. An animal made from vegetables and/or fruit
- 8. Any other vegetable not listed in the schedule
- 9. Three fruits of any variety
- 10. Three different culinary herbs tied in a bunch

## **CHILDREN'S SECTION:**

To be judged in two age groups: up to seven years, and eight to eleven years old.

- A. A miniature garden in a seed tray
- B. A posy of garden flowers arranged in a mug
- C. An animal made from vegetables and/or fruit

A number of trophies will be awarded. Please note only Barton under Needwood Gardening Guild Members will be eligible to compete for these awards.
